Re: Opportunity to be a return collection site for the PaintCare OR Pilot

PaintCare, NPCA's new non-profit that will be implementing the OR Paint Pilot with the assistance of Product Care, the Canadian non-profit that manages multiple stewardship program's throughout that Country, is developing the paint stewardship program in Oregon as mandated by the recently passed legislation. The proposed program commencement date is April 1, 2010.

The program will allow consumers to return leftover household paint to collection locations throughout the State at no charge. We are currently identifying retail return collection locations for the program and invite you to consider this opportunity to provide an added service to existing customers and potentially attract new business. Retail collection will also help in keeping program costs for collection as low as possible.

The program will supply collection bins including pickup and drop off, training and all supplies at no cost to you. The following is an outline of the roles and responsibilities for retailers agreeing to act as a collection depot.

PaintCare/Product Care supplies:

- usually 2 collection bins (see picture below - stackable, 4 foot square base by 3 feet high)
- on site training
- collection site reference manual (site operating instructions, information on products accepted, product list, transportation information etc...)
- a spill kit
- delivery of empty bins and pickup of full bins by the program's transportation contractor
- consumer brochures and signage
- transport and recycling costs for the collected paint
- listing of your site as an collection site on website and other program promotion opportunities

The retailer acting as a Paint Collection Site will:

- accept leftover program paint (but not non-program material) from the public during operating hours
- place paint cans in a collection bin/drums provided, properly packed
- provide secure storage during non-operating hours
- assist in loading and unloading of full and empty bins and the completion of the required paperwork (forklift or loading dock required)

- ensure staff are trained so that the collection service is provided in accordance with the training manual guidelines
- post signage
- display consumer brochures

We encourage you to reply as soon as possible as locations may be limited.
