

## Colorado Paint Stewardship Program

PRELIMINARY EXECUTIVE SUMMARY FOR 2016 ANNUAL REPORT

PaintCare is an industry stewardship organization representing paint manufacturers that must comply with the requirements of Senate Bill 14-029 (Concerning the establishment of a paint stewardship program for the environmentally sound disposal of architectural paint).

## **Objectives**

- Provide cost savings to local government-run household hazardous waste collection (HHW) programs.
- Increase the number of postconsumer paint drop-off sites for households and businesses statewide.
- Exemplify the principles of a product-centered approach to environmental protection, also referred to as product stewardship.

## **Highlights**

- 155 year-round sites (137 retailers, 8 HHW facilities, 5 recycle centers, 3 latex paint recyclers, 1 transfer station, 1 landfill).
- 93.4% of Colorado residents have a year-round site within 15 miles, exceeding the law's 90% requirement.
- Additional sites to date: 53 HHW events, 28 paint-only drop-off events, and 6 retailers with limited participation.
- Picked up paint 121 times from 100 unique businesses, institutions or households with more than 300 gallons.
- Processed 672,029 gallons of postconsumer paint in 2016. (75% latex and 25% oil based).
- Latex: 70% was made into recycled paint, 5% was reused, 6% used as alternative daily landfill cover, and 19% was unrecyclable/landfilled.
- Oil-based: paint made up about 25% of the total paint; and 96% was used as a fuel; 4% was reused.
- 236 tons of metal and plastic containers were recycled.
- The paint recovery rate was 5.0% (gallons processed divided by gallons sold in the same period).
