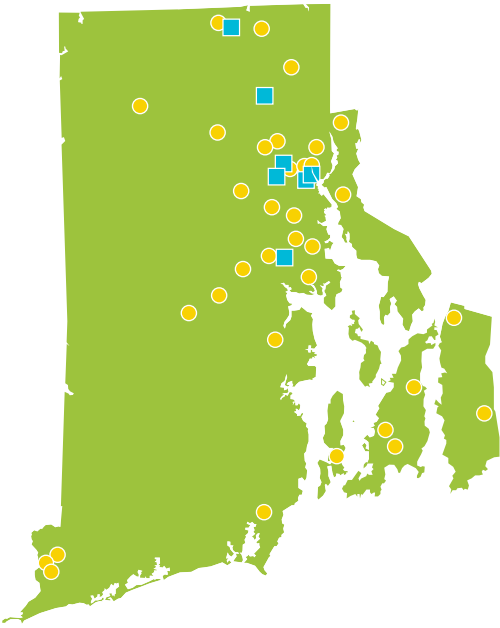




Thank You Rhode Island for Recycling Your Paint

PaintCare makes it easy to recycle unwanted paint

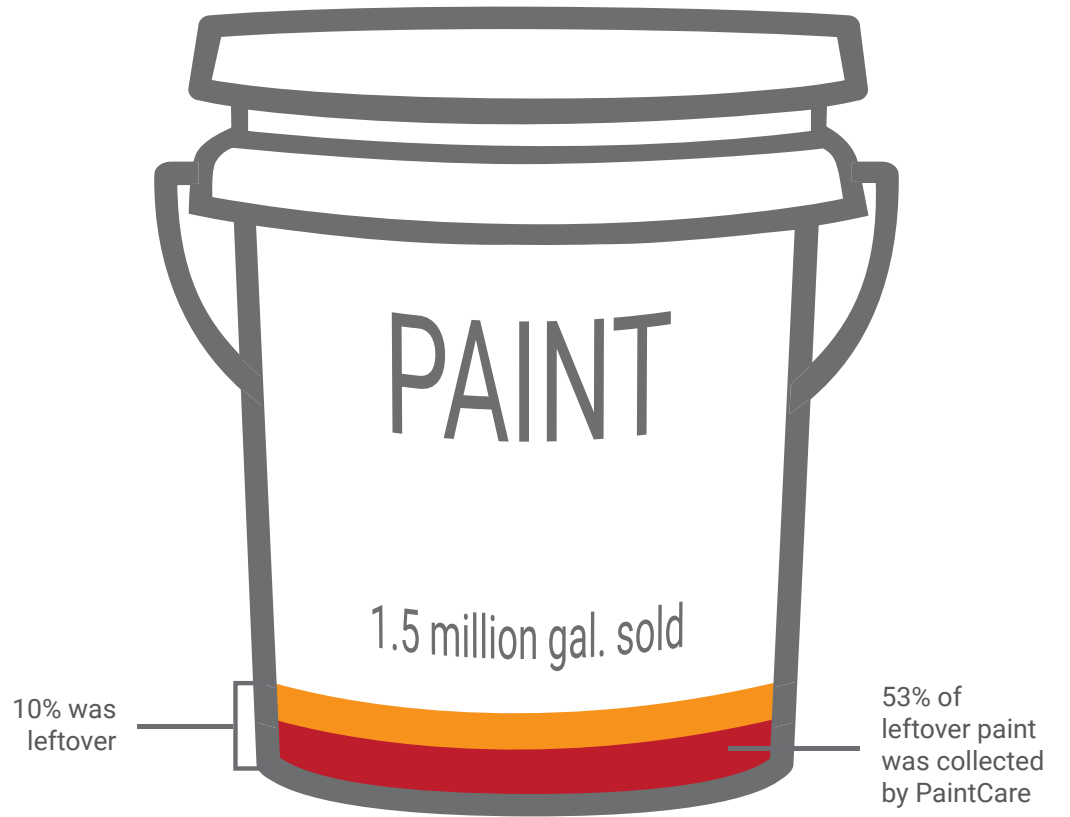

● Paint Drop-Off Sites ■ Large Volume Pick-Ups

PaintCare established 34 year-round paint drop-off sites; 99.9% of Rhode Island households are within 15 miles of a PaintCare site. We also picked up large amounts (300+ gallons) of paint directly from 8 places.

PaintCare collected more than half of the paint leftover from new paint purchases.

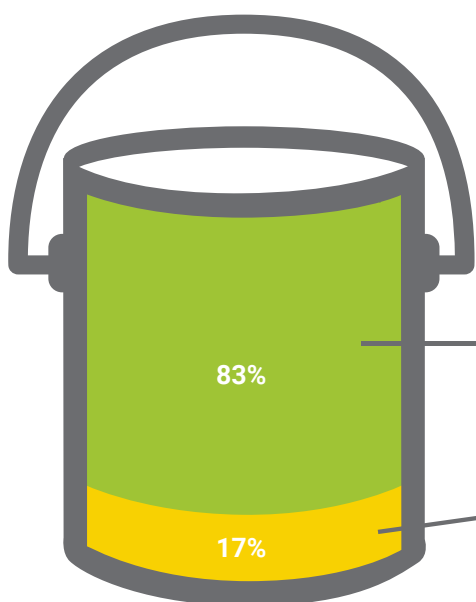


The amount of paint collected by PaintCare totaled 80,643 gallons. That's enough to fill almost 9 large tanker trucks.

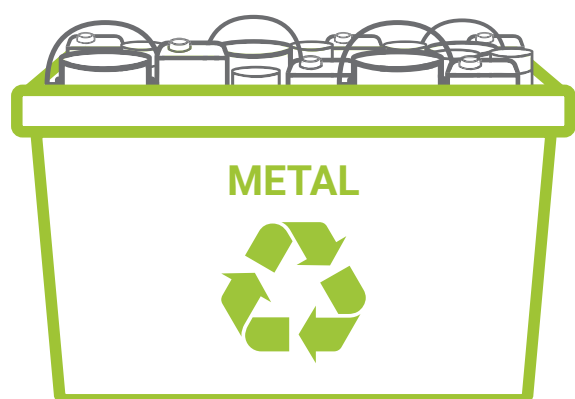
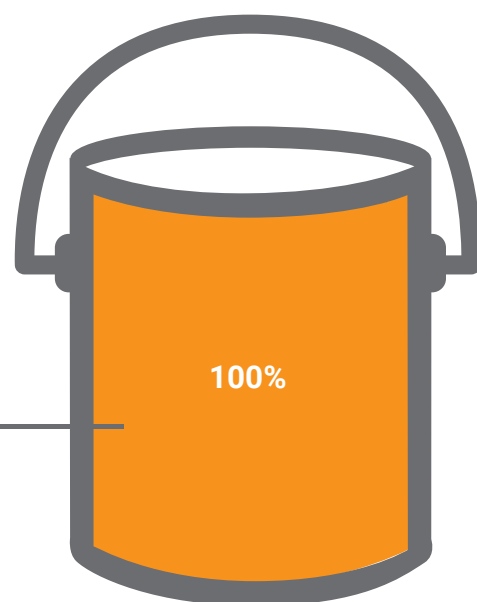


Latex paint made up 80% of the total paint collected.
