#### Questions 1 and 2

Skip Sections 1 and 2 if the paint is at a household.

For the purposes of this service and the PaintCare Program, businesses include government agencies, non-profits, and any entity that is not a household. If you work for government, enter your department or agency name for business name and enter "government" for type of business.

### Question 2

Enter Y or N in the orange box. When estimating how much hazardous waste your business generates per month, include all chemicals (paint, thinner, pesticdes, acids, etc.) that you would normally have managed by a hazardous waste company, then subtract water-based (latex) paint.

220 pounds is approximately equivalent to 100 kilograms or 20-30 gallons depending on the material. Answer as follows:

N if business generates MORE than 220 lbs. of oil-based paint and other hazardous waste per month Y if business generates LESS than 220 lbs. of oil-based paint and other hazardous waste per month
